A Public Meeting on the Update of the *Standard Practice for the Testing of Volatile Organic Emissions from Various Sources Using Small-Scale Environmental Chambers (“Standard Practice”)*

SUMMARY:

The CDPH Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Program invites interested parties, including California agency stakeholders, building material and furnishing manufacturers, testing laboratories, certification programs, and organizations that have adopted “Section 01350”, to attend this meeting on the update of the *Standard Practice*. The IAQ Program will present details of its draft version for an initial update (“Version 1.1”), and outline its plan for drafting the next generation (“Version 2.0”) with subject-matter expert input. Our targets are to issue Version 1.1 by the end of 2009 and a draft Version 2.0 by the end of 2010.

PURPOSES OF THE MEETING:

- Present technical aims of initial and next generation updates of the *Standard Practice*;
- Discuss details of the initial update (Version 1.1), including addressing OEHHA’s updated Chronic Reference Exposure Levels (REL) for formaldehyde and acetaldehyde;
- Identify subject-matter experts and form work groups for Version 2.0 and ongoing revision and maintenance of the *Standard Practice*.
